Background

Following the completion of and approval of the 2014-2017 BCE Strategic Plan, the Board developed standards to evaluate expert consultants and defined their responsibilities to establish consistency among expert consultant reports. Following modifications to the Subject Expert Matter (SME) program, questions remained regarding the efficacy of the program. In an effort to address the program's existing deficiencies in the training materials and the recruitment process, Committee members agreed to complete a review of the program.

Prior to the May 31, 2018 meeting, staff completed a comprehensive review of the SME program. Upon completion of the review, staff determined that there were several policy questions for the Committee to discuss before moving forward with any changes to the program.

At the May 31, 2018 meeting, the Committee approved staff recommendations to require minimum qualification criteria for SME application submission. Additionally, the Committee approved amendments to the existing SME application form.

At the October 10, 2018 meeting, staff provided the Committee with a proposed 1- page document enumerating SME application requirements. The Committee also reviewed the revised SME application form and asked staff to make additional revisions. The Committee anticipates that revisions to the criteria and standards for SME recruitment will improve effectiveness and consistency of the program.

Subject Matter Expert Program

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) established the Subject Matter Expert program as an impartial means to support the investigation and enforcement functions of the Board. The program consists of a statewide pool of skilled licensed chiropractors who consult with Board staff, review case materials and records, prepare written reports and testify at administrative hearings.

Minimum Qualifications

To be considered for an appointment as a subject matter expert, applicants must meet the minimum qualifications shown below:

- Have ten (10) or more years of licensed professional experience with the last five (5) years in active practice. Possess a current and valid license in good standing.
- Have an active practice (defined as 80 hours a month in direct patient care, clinical activity, or teaching, at least forty (40) hours of which is in direct patient care).
- No current or prior disciplinary action pending or taken against any professional license in California
 or any other state or territory. No criminal convictions, including any that were expunged or
 dismissed.
- Knowledgeable in the practice, laws, regulations and community standards of care for the practice of chiropractic in the State of California.

Qualities of a Successful Subject Matter Expert

As a Subject Matter Expert, you must be able to: review facts independently and impartially; review investigative case materials and prepare thorough and concise reports; interpret and apply sections of state law governing the practice of chiropractic; have effective communication, both when testifying and in writing reports; provide a written report describing the standard of care applicable to a given case; establish whether or not a departure from the standard of care or unprofessional conduct occurred; maintain confidentiality; able to complete and submit a written opinion within 30 days of receipt of case materials; willing to assist investigators, prosecutors, and administrative law judges in understanding the chiropractic aspects of a case; must understand the necessity of maintaining the minimum standards of the practice of chiropractic; not act as advocate for the board or the respondent chiropractor; understand the Board's role as a regulatory agency and its responsibilities to consumers of chiropractic services and the profession.

Testimony at Administrative Hearings

As a Board expert witness, you may be required to testify at administrative hearings held before an administrative law judge for cases you have reviewed, which may also require minimal travel.

Reimbursement for Subject Matter Expert Reviews

Subject matter experts are reimbursed on a case-by-case basis. The Board pays experts at the rate of \$ 100 per hour for record and case review, preparation of a written report and/or conference with Attorney General. Testimony at hearings range from \$600 maximum allowable fee per half day and \$1200 maximum allowable fee per full day.

Background

The Licensing & Continuing Education Committee met on September 25th, 2018 to review and discuss possible definitions for the subject area 'Public Health', the list of Chiropractic Adjustive Techniques provided by California chiropractic colleges, language for the proposed CPR regulations and to review suggestions for Continuing Education (CE) regulations.

Definitions for subject area 'Public Health'

The Committee reviewed potential definitions to the term 'public health', for possible inclusion to further define the subject area. This would assist staff when reviewing CE course applications and CE providers when submitting a course for CE credit. The Committee reviewed the proposed definition for any language that is too vague, narrow or broad. The Committee suggested that staff provide their proposed exclusions to the definition of 'public health' at the next Committee Meeting.

<u>List of Chiropractic Adjustive Technique Provided by California Chiropractic Colleges</u>

The Committee reviewed the list of chiropractic adjustive techniques as provided by the three Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) approved California chiropractic colleges. To assist staff who are reviewing CE course applications, the Board requested staff compile a list of adjustive and manipulative techniques utilized in chiropractic





college curriculum and in faculty advised, student-led clubs. After reviewing the material, the Committee requested an expansion of the list by contacting all Chiropractic Specialty Boards and all Board approved chiropractic colleges throughout the United States, for their own list of chiropractic adjustive techniques.

Proposed CPR Regulatory Language

The Committee reviewed proposed language for a new Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Basic Life Support (BLS) regulation. The Committee made several suggestions for changes to the proposed language. Staff will continue to work on revisions to the proposed language.

Suggestions to Continuing Education Regulations

The Committee reviewed several proposed changes to various segments of the CE regulations, including, Alternate Pathways, Provider Qualifications, Definition of a "Course", Denial and Appeal Process, and Licensee Reporting Requirements. The Committee, staff and members of the public made suggestions for changes to the proposed regulations. The Committee will continue to review proposed regulations after additional research has been conducted by staff.
